Board discussed and decided Anderson gravel held up good last year and would use them again. Richard Moore moved to accept and Greg Langer second. Approved.

Dale Kuchinka submitted a bid for ~~the~~ road ditch mowing \$31.00 per mile.

Board accepted this bid. only one received. Anathu hole in Kluever road. will have this checked seems to be undermining from somewhere. Also Eulith Culvert - use a double plaster wall over pass.
