Gregg Langen has a booklet made up for sign replacements. Federal regulations are that we have to have a plan. Rules have changed saying we have to replace signs as needed. All signs are here & stored at Otte Construction.

There is a stop sign on 290th that needs to be replaced (Lace & Boyum.)
