The Greenville Town Board met Thursday  
May 17, 2012 at 7:00 pm at the ~~town~~ <sup>Town</sup> Hall with all members present.

Chairman Bob Winter called the meeting to order and the pledge was said.

Click read the minutes from April. Richard Moore moved to accept and ~~Robert~~ Dave Roehl second. Approved.

Linda Dally, who bought Jay Peisky property, came to explain her plan for next ~~year~~ <sup>year</sup>. She has plans for more sheds and another driveway going out to the east. May have several semis in during growing season.

Dave's house has been moved in and just sit there for now. Has to do a subdivision to get building rights from property across the highway. Scott O'Keefe inspected the house before it was moved.

Talked about fee schedule for Inspect as to township fees. Table for now.

Deputy Shawn came to the meeting and was reporting that there has been an increase of mail ~~box~~ thefts. No one had any concerns at this time.

Myron Langefeld, along with his realtor came before the board with a request. St. John's Lutheran Church

in Webster is interested in buying 9 acres to build a church on. Not sure if this has been rezoned commercial or if it is still Agricultural. Clerk will check with Dean Johnson from Resource Strategies as how to proceed with this.

Perry Mulligan along with Ken Langestog came before the board. Ken is buying 3 acres and the Tom Mulligan home. He wants to put up a pole building. Also checking Septic system, was put in about 2001.

Alan Mohr has 10 acres in Grunvale and is wondering what he can do with it. As it stands now. He needs to get a building site from an adjoining property with one to make his buildable. He will check.

Beenie Budin has a concern about Kirby property. Pheasant's forever has it but is not keeping up - regarding weeds & such. Bob said he would check with D.N.R. Brian Watson from SWCD has a concern with erosion.

MnSpart inspector has requested we put up a box to leave off plans. Eric Christenson said he would get Scott a key for town hall so he can drop off inside.

The new ~~str~~ road signs have been purchased. The government has decided now it is too much of a burden on township government to redo all signs. The ones that were purchased are to replace mostly the faded out ones. Will start until each one needs to be replaced. Street names will be done at a later date.

Township is required to put signs on the bridge on Evelith. Will order and put up. 2 preceding and 2 on regarding weight limits.

Jerry Anderson & Dean Odette from the Rural Fire Association come before the board to get a resolution signed to present to City of Northfork in regard to building, fire trucks, city & rural, and other issues concerning fire protection. Richard Moore moved to sign joint power agreement. Dave Raehl second. Approved. Agreement was signed. Jerry Anderson is taking this back to City.

Got a letter for booking gas for heating town hall from Central Valley. Board decided not to book.

Short courses will be in Rochester on June 21. 3 will attend.

Asked Bruce Otte about graveling.

He thought it would begin the last week in May.

Clarence Valbut ~~bridge~~ needs some fill in - Monte Griniqu - wash out. Klauw road wash out. Otis' dee taking care of these.

There is a concern about how close to the road several farmers are doing their crops. Field is washing ~~it~~ into the roads. town board should contact the farmers.
