

The Grunwald Town Board met July 18, 2013 at 7.00 pm at the town Hall with all members present

Chairman Reshard Moore called the meeting to order and the pledge was said

Clerk read the minutes from June. Dove Rock moved to accept and Greg Langew second Approved.

Bayam property sites were discussed. There is always a concern about lots when they are kind of broken up sections. The County was going to map this out, but did not get the grant for this project. Greg Langew said he would check on the matter that do this kind of work. Well try to get this done soon. Will bring names in August or September.

Rusty Klumler ditch & culvert were discussed. Township will clean out north side. Will put in a 30' culvert & across can add more at the same time.

Don Swenson is concerned about road into property. Daughter may build a new home on this. Tabled as he did not show up for meeting.

A deputy from the County was there, Still having a few break-ins. Check for names when garbage is dumped.

Greg Langan asked Rick to send a letter to Bob Segner to get his records to the town hall. Greg made a motion & Dave Raehl-second approved.

Greg Langan received an e-mail from the dust control people to get paid at this meeting. There was discussion as to the amount that was used compared to last year. Greg made a motion to pay & Dave Raehl-second & we will ask them to come to next meeting to explain. More shlarde is to be done yet when road work is done.

Greg Langan reported that the NCRWMO has sent new report to BWSR for approval. Meeting on Aug 12 in site. He will attend.

July 24 will be a Coalition meeting at City of Northfall at 7:00pm.

Ed Carlick has a concern about conflict of interest in regard to moving lawn. Richard Moore said his son Kevin is mowing & he receives no money from this project. His son is in college &

does not live at home because of college. Stays at home intermittently.

Richard was very upset and resigned his position of supervisor. Residents in attendance were upset also tried to calm him.

Roads -

Had another rain storm of 6"-8" of rain. Many had washouts. Roads had to be closed & barricaded for a time until washouts could be fixed. Some culverts were assessed as not big enough so during the works supervisor decided to put in new ones so as not to have the washouts all the time. Bryce & Co will get new culverts & install. Will delay road work for a short time. Should be 24" x 30"

A roadway plan:

Township will eat up culvert prices to get them done.

Should: 35 spot loads have been done so far.

Will ask land owners to help pay for Culverts.

Phone lines will have to be spalled by before digging. Bryce will do this.

Aggregate will be tested at County when grading.

David Fregault was in attendance, he would like to see more information on line as to what is being done on the roads & such. More visibility as to plans.

A comment was ~~made~~ by Mark Malucha that Jerry Bolton should be compensated for the use of his pick-up when doing road inspections & such. Maybe a gas card?

Rene CO #55 was discussed, usually we bill them ~~\$700~~ ^{\$150-\$1000} per year. Bruce suggested we ask them to put some gravel on as road is getting bad. Greg Lange said he would contact ~~them~~ Bare County Highway Department.

Railroad right of way on Euclid is getting bad.

Barriers were discussed, township should buy the ones with reflectors. Bruce Otte will get some prices. We used Pitti's this last time when roads were washed out.

Ambulance papers were not signed as the board feels this is a good organization & should not stop.

Contracts for road maintenance were discussed. Rude did not send one & Byrd & Otter said they are interested again & will raise their price \$10.00, as they have stayed the same. Gas prices have stayed up. Otter's one goal to keep the board posted as to what is going on on the roads by attending every meeting.

Ketchum Moore was asked to finish out his term and he said he would. He is very involved with the road committee.

Bills were acted on & paid.
