There is a meeting coming up on May 23 at Eureka Township for the NCRWMO. to adapt the new watershed plan.

Mowing the town hall, Angie Minar gave Greg Lange a proposal for mowing. \$90.00 per time. Kevin Moore had been doing it for \$9000 per time. Has been doing it for several years. Dave Roehl moved to have Kevin keep doing it. Richard Moore second. Greg Lange voted against. There is a concern of a family member doing this. Will check with other townships who have supervisors doing work.
